BLUF: (b)(6) can mandate students utilize gov't lodging if available.

A commander has discretion to issue any lawful order, such as mandating students utilize gov't lodging if available.

An order is considered lawful when:

1. it is issued by a competent authority;
2. the order is properly communicated; and
3. there is a nexus between the order and the military duty (includes all activities reasonably necessary to accomplish a military mission, or safeguard or promote the morale, discipline, and usefulness of members of a command)

An order is presumed to be lawful until challenged by a servicemember

In this case (b)(6) is a competent authority. As the installation commander, he has authority to issue such a mandate. The order will have to be clearly communicated, preferably through a local OI, guidance memo, or placed on members orders. If through a local OI or guidance memo, it should be placed on the AF e-pubs site so anyone can access it. With regard to the third factor, (b)(6) will have to articulate a military nexus for the order, i.e. need to keep RPA students together for training purposes, save gov't money, etc.

If a military member decides to violate the order, i.e. be housed downtown, from a finance perspective, they will still be reimbursed but limited to the gov't qtrs. lodging reimbursement cost. From a disciplinary perspective, it will be up to the squadron commander how they decide to handle the violation of the lawful order.
