Chief,

Of the current pilots, 54 out of 103 or 52% choose to live off-base. Of the off-base pilots, 27 are 2LTs, 19 are Capt or Maj. The rest are foreign & CAE.

Of the current sensors 13 out of 68 or 19% choose off-base. Of the off-base sensors, 8 are foreign students, 4 are guard/reserve & 1 CAE. Zero pipeliners at this moment.

One possible explanation for the decrease in lodging revenue this year is that we reduced our number of students by 21%, which would correspond fairly closely to the decrease in revenue you told me on the phone. In FY14, we had 635 students (versus a projection of 500 this FY). In FY14, 26% (166) lived off base and another 13% lived in the dorm (thus not producing revenue for lodging). For FY15, there's been 55 SOs who have lived in the dorm. This is 11% of the annual total (500), with another 64 students (pilots and SOs) yet to show for FY15, so that number could climb slightly. Please let me know what follow-on questions you have.
